4. MATH: Both the grade 1s and 2s have finished their patterning unit. The grade 1s have started their shapes unit, while the grade 2s have started their polygons unit. The majority of the class can currently count to 200 independently! We will be working on skip counting (by 2s, 5s, 10s) over the next while. The majority of the students can currently sequence the days of the week and the months of the year. Please practice these skills with your child.

5. RELIGION: We are learning Glory Be and correctly making the sign of the cross. We have also been talking about the four parts of mass and the significance of each part.

6. SCIENCE: We will start with the grade 1 unit about seasonal and daily changes.

7. WRITING: All of the students are working on re-reading their work so that they ensure that they have included:

-capitals at the beginning of sentences

-capitals at the beginning of names

-periods at the end of sentences

-recording appropriate sounds when sounding out new words

-using the word wall to check spelling
